POTENTIAL COLLABORATIVE PARTNERSHIP

The Racine Dominicans and Lincoln Lutheran of Racine have entered into discussions focusing on a potential collaborative partnership on the Siena Center site which is currently home to the sisters and their outreach of spirituality, truth, and justice. Together the two parties are exploring the possibility of designing and guiding a faith-based campus which would embrace the sisters' mission as well as Lincoln Lutheran's full continuum of health care, including independent living, assisted living, skilled nursing, and memory care residences.

In addition to carrying the ministerial traditions of both Lincoln Lutheran and the Racine Dominicans into a broader future, making the services of each even more accessible, the development would honor and conserve the natural environment of the beautiful site on the shore of Lake Michigan, five miles north of downtown Racine.
